

Technical Industries Job Description

Maintenance Superintendent.

- To maintain and repair all equipment and structures as needed.
- To assist in the design and the fabrication of inspection equipment and structures.
- To make sure that the operators of the fork lift machines and all trucks and units checked each morning before starting the engines, check oil, fuel, and water and tire pressure. No equipment parts may be taken out without being immediately replaced.
- Make sure your work area is safe. Make sure employee names are written on the hard hats, gloves and safety glasses.
- Make sure all fire extinguishers are in working order and placed around the buildings and near areas such as the fuel tank, oil storage area and welding area.
- Make sure that all roads are in good conditions NO MUD HOLES, TURTLE BACK all roads.
- Make sure all drainage ditches kept clean.
- Make sure the grass kept cut at both the storage yard and the Miller Road house.
- Make sure all 3rd party personnel and outside contractors working in the yard works safely and follow company policy. Report anyone who does not perform.
- Make sure you get a minimum of three quotes on all purchases you make, get the best price.
- Make sure all hand tools and small equipment such as (air compressor, welding machine, cutting torch, pressure washer, battery charger, grinders, and saw) are picked up and stored in a locked area at the end of each working day.
- To check for safety hazards daily and report any hazards found to safety supervisor or your supervisor.
- To perform all jobs given to him by his supervisor safely.

- Must have a minimum of 3 years experience in mechanical, technical, diesel engine repairs, light welding, fabrication and safety operation.
- Should learn ASNT certification minimum level 1 in UT, MT, Dye Pentrant, MPI & EMI.
